# Frequently asked Questions...

Here are a few questions parents often like to ask...

# What do we need to bring?

All children are required to wear appropriate clothing (clothes suitable for getting a bit messy in, and safe footwear). Children also like to bring their own bottle of water and a snack if desired. Our term-class students are encouraged to have a 'visual dairy' to sketch in and collect ideas - so this is always relevant to bring to class and even in one-off classes I encourage students to bring in any drawings or references they might like to use or share. In some workshops we do ask for other thinkgs such as a t-shirt or photo of the child however this will be specified in the program outline.

## How many children will be in a workshop?

The maximum numbers depends on the location and nature of the workshop. Usually there is a minimum of 4 or 6 for a class to run and maximum is often 8, though in larger venues these numbers may change but we still aim for a 1:8 teacher/student ratio by having an additional teacher or teacher's aide present.

### How many teachers are present in a workshop?

One teacher will conduct the class, and in larger sized groups a second teacher or teacher's aide will also be involved.

### Can parents stay in the workshop?

The workshops are specifically designed for children and we encourage parents not to stay. We do however recognise some children need time to settle into a new environment, so are happy if parents want to stay for the first part of the workshop to ensure their little one feels secure. We also recognise that children with special needs may need extra support of their parent and we are happy to accommodate this.

#### Are the children accompanied to the bathroom during the workshop?

In most of our venues the toilets are adjacent to the studio space - if they are further away we ensure that children are accompanied by the teacher's aide.

#### Do the children get a break during the workshop?

In classes over 1.5 hours a short break is set in the middle and children should bring a snack from home. In 1.5 hours or shorter children will naturally take time to have a drink, go to the toilet or simply pause to reflect on their artwork.

#### Do all the team have a working with children's card?

Yes! A current Qld Blue Card is held by all teachers and aides working with the children's classes. These will be displayed in our enrolment/check-in folder.

### My child is 7 but would like to attend the 8-12 year old's workshop... is this possible?

The age definitions given for each workshop are guides only. We recognise that each child develops at a different rate and that a 7 year old child may have the motor skills required to complete a project in the 8-12 workshop. We find that a mix of ages usually works quite well in classes as they are small groups and everyone is getting individualised attention and working at their own pace. However some activities are better suited for specific ages - just ask and we can discuss your specific child's suitability for a class.
